





Mentor jackets connects alumni and current Georgia Tech students in mutually fulfilling mentoring relationships focused on academic, personal, and professional goals.







What the interview process was like for this role

The interviewing process was tough. I spoke with several senior engineers and hiring managers during the day. My work required a security clearance designation, so there were quite a few questions about background information in the interview. Fortunately, I completed the interviewing procedures well. The recruiters commented that I did exceptionally well in their preliminary talks. I had a Recruiting Agency that helped place me with this company, so employment placement agencies usually are helpful to most applicants.







FEW, BUT MIGHTY


